As of April 8th, 2024, Kolby McKay has been taken into police custody after willingly turning himself over to the appropriate authorities.

With the emergency situation now de-escalated, the Spirit Lake Tribe asks that you remain vigilant in safeguarding the community as we navigate its aftermath and work towards a safer environment for all members.

Our focus now turns to a commitment to foster healing and support during this challenging period, ensuring that all the mental health needs of our community are met with compassion and care. As a tribal nation we offer our deepest sympathies to those affected by recent events, especially the families who are experiencing loss and trauma.
