- Utilize American Indian Life Skills Development Curriculum (AILSDC)
- Assist families and people at risk for suicide with information on local prevention (cultural and mental health resources)
- Must be available for evening and week end youth activities as required
- Must participate in project training, meetings, and evaluation activities as required
- Serves as liaison between project staff and assigned tribal entities
