Qualifications Include:

- Applicant must be currently enrolled or enrolling in an accredited post-secondary institution.
- Applicant must be a member of the Spirit Lake Tribe.
- Required to carry 12 or more credits per term.
- Term and cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher on a 4.0 basis.
- Applications are due on or before September 24, 2021.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- One half of the amount awarded will be paid in the fall semester.
 Spring semester payment is conditioned on proof of full time enrollment and term and cumulative grade point of 2.0 on 4.0 scale.

The Helen Bergstrom Ernst Scholarship Trust is a private foundation and is exempt from federal income tax under 501 (C)(3). Contributions to the trust are eligible for tax deductions and can be directed to:
