**Position Summary: The Water Operator is responsible for the successful operation of the Spirit Lake Tribe's Water Treatment plant and distribution system.**

**Major Duties:**

- To provide operation and maintenance of all water infrastructures on the Spirit Lake Tribe
- Performs duties related to water infrastructure, repairs water lines, repairs valve and fire hydrants.
- Reads meters, monitors pump.
- Ensures that the Water Treatment plant is operational and maintained.
- Ensures the potable water on the Spirit Lake Tribe is safe and drinkable.
- Provide aide to other departments as assigned and perform work order request in a timely and professional manner.
- Individual will maintain a regular inspection schedule of the water distribution system, equipment and facilities.
- Maintain up to date and accurate records and daily logs of operating conditions of the water distribution system.
- Inspect and monitor any and all work done by others contractual or otherwise for the purpose of performing routine maintenance or repairs in maintaining the water system.
- Ability to follow and understand technical instructions and direction.
- On call 24/7 to respond to emergency situations affecting the water system.

**Qualifications**

- Must have water distribution and treatment certification 1 or be willing to get water distributions and treatment certification level 2.
- Two years' experience in the repair/maintenance of electrical, hydraulics, welding, plumbing, construction, pipeline installation and mechanical equipment and machinery.
- High school diploma.
- Must be able to operate various types of equipment including backhoe, mini excavator, skid steer.
- Must possess excellent management and organizational skills.

- Comprehensive knowledge of policies, practices and concepts of the Spirit Lake Tribe Water Management.
- Provides information and responds to inquiries in person and over the telephone.
- Must possess and maintain a current, active and unrestricted ND Driver's license through course of employment, insurable under SLT driving policy.
- Must be dependable and able to work unsupervised.
- Computer knowledge and proficiency required.
