Job Title: Summer Youth Supervisor Open Date: April 24, 2025

Position Objective: The Summer Youth Employment program is more than a job placement program, it is a valuable summer employment and training experience that will lead youth to a sense of accomplishment, instill strong work ethics, increase and/or reinforce the youth participants' awareness between educational and vocational skills, acquisitions and enhance the future employability of youth participating in the program.

Major Duties & Responsibilities:

- Supervise and participate with groups of youth that are engaged in a variety of employment and training activities.
- Manages the relationship between the Employment & Training Program and the Summer Youth Employment worksites to ensure relevant work experience and worksite supervision of assigned youth.
- Makes referrals to appropriate work sites and/or agencies based on the youth participants qualifications and needs.
- Maintains, completes and processes required forms and/or paperwork for the participants' files.
- Assists in establishing and maintaining files (Summer Youth Employment Program)
- Visits and monitors worksite activity on a daily basis.
- Complete weekly monitoring reports of visited worksites.
- Monitors attendance, collects and processes timesheets.
- Teaches guides or otherwise instructs youth.
- Serves as a leader and a role-model.
- Assists with training sessions.
- Assist with daily set-up, daily clean up and transportation.
- Carry out the goals, themes and schedule of the program to provide a consistent and high quality experience for the summer youth participants.

Qualifications, Experience and education required:

- Must have a minimum of a High School Diploma or GED.
- Must pass a pre-employment drug test and will be subject to random drug testing.
- Must possess and maintain a valid Class D Driver's License and have reliable transportation.
- Subject to background check.

- Experience working with youth ages 14-24.
- Experience implementing youth activities and supervising youth groups of 8 to 20.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Ability to establish and maintain cooperative working relationship with young people as well as worksite personnel.

- Ability to physically perform the essential functions of the job and be able to lift 50 pounds.
